Terroir, location: Originates from the Rosenberg, Setzgarten, Alsen and

Neuberg vineyards. All vineyards that guarantee Zwei-

gelt grapes a good ripeness.

Vinification: The aim is to produce a distinctive type of white wine

from the red Zweigelt grape. We make sure that the must has no contact with the skins. When the grapes are destemmed and crushed, the must is left to run off by itself before pressing, thus extracting hardly any color from the skins. Cool fermentation and maturation on fine lees in stainless steel underlines the fresh,

eleaant character.

Characteristics: Bright, radiant rosé, delicate aroma of red berries and

citrus fruits, fruity and mineral on the palate with a re-

freshing interplay of fruit sweetness and acidity.

Food recommendation: Light starters, exotically seasoned salads, baked mus-

hrooms, artichoke bases au gratin with Parmesan, Asian and Mediterranean-inspired dishes (tempura, curry

dishes, pizza with tuna and anchovies).
